### Invitation for Expression of Interest:

**Postdoctoral Research Assignment** "Synthesis, characterization and operation of modified Ni-based electro-catalysts/electrodes for Solid Oxide Cells under steam electrolysis conditions (SOECs)"

The Institute of Chemical Engineering Sciences, Foundation of Research and Technology - Hellas, (FORTH/ICE- HT) is seeking applicants for one postdoctoral research assignment in the context of the research project "Novel SOE architectures for hydrogen production (NOAH2)" - Grant Agreement number: 101137600, which is implemented under the HORIZON EUROPE, HORIZON-JTI-CLEANH2-2023-1.

# Job Description

To conduct research under a work assignment or a fixed-term employment contract in the framework of the aforementioned project "Novel SOE architectures for hydrogen production \_ Project acronym: NOAH2 \_ P. No 101137600". The aim of this research is to understand the degradation and lifetime operation fundamentals of new Solid Oxide Cell (SOC) fuel electrodes, developed with novel chemical synthesis methods, at high (750 – 900 °C) and intermediate (600 – 750 °C) temperature  $H_2O$  electrolysis and fuel cell operation conditions.

### Location: FORTH/ICE-HT, Patras, Greece

**Duration:** up to 12 months, with the potential of renewal or extension according to the needs of the project

**Fellowship**: up to approximately 2300 € per month (total cost of the employer, including social security and taxes) depending on the qualifications and time devoted to project **Envisaged starting date**: 1/6/2024

- Research experience, of at least 24 months after obtaining the PhD degree, in the investigation of materials and electrochemical processes for the production of H<sub>2</sub> and/or electrical energy as described in the topic of the research assignment
- Awards and scientific publications in international peer-reviewed journals, relative to the subject of the research assignment
- Knowledge of the English language at least at B2 level

# **Application Submission**

In order to be considered, the application must include:

- Scanned copies of academic titles and language knowledge certificates
- Copy of PhD thesis
- Copies of awards and scientific publications in international peer-reviewed journals
- Employer's certificate of the work experience and any other official document to certify the aforementioned required qualifications

Any application received after the deadline will not be considered for the selection.

### **Selection Procedure**

Applications that are received on time will be evaluated by a scientific committee using the criteria mentioned above. If necessary, certain candidates will be invited to a personal interview with the committee.



Interview Criteria:

(a) Background in the objective of the assignment (5 points). (b) Organizational and communication skills (5 points). (c) Team-spirit and self-motivation (5 points). (d) Commitment to achieving the goals (5 points)

The outcome of the selection will be announced on the website of FORTH/ICE-HT as well as on the website of "DIAVGEIA".
